WHEREAS, there are eight open seats on the Human Rights and Equal Economic Opportunity Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Human Rights and Equal Economic Opportunity commissioners and department staff have reviewed applications and conducted interviews of interested applicants; and

WHEREAS, Human Rights and Equal Economic Opportunity leadership have recommended Nonkululeko Shongwe, Krystle Igbo-Ogbonna, Mala Thao, Jennifer Thorson, Amane Badhasso, and Naomi Alemseged for appointment as commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Carter wishes to appoint Nonkululeko Shongwe, Krystle Igbo-Ogbonna, Mala Thao, Jennifer Thorson, Amane Badhasso, and Naomi Alemseged to the Human Rights and Equal Employment Opportunity Commission for three-year terms ending on June 1, 2024; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council consents to the appointment Nonkululeko Shongwe, Krystle Igbo-Ogbonna, Mala Thao, Jennifer Thorson, Amane Badhasso, and Naomi Alemseged to the Human Rights and Equal Employment Opportunity Commission for three-year terms ending on June 1, 2024.
