Staff Comments: Hauler records show that there were no payments made during Quarter 1 2021. However, they did inform staff that the mailing address was incorrectly set for the previous property owner during Quarter 1 2021 & Quarter 2 2021. Therefore staff recommends reducing the assessment from \$218.13 to \$189.69 to remove the total late fees of \$28.44. Staff will also reduce the Quarter 2 2021 assessment to \$189.69.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during January to March 2021.
