Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): Property owner was promised by "the Head of the Department" at Advanced that a \$5.00 error in billing made by Advanced would be fixed.

Staff Comments: Hauler confirmed that there were no call records with the property owner regarding the \$5.00 billing error. However, they requested that staff remove the assessment. Therefore staff recommends removing the assessment.
