Amending the financing and spending plans in the Fire Department for a contribution received from the State to pay for training and equipment for the hazardous materials team.

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota has awarded a contribution of \$260,000 to the Fire Department to pay for training and equipment for the hazardous materials response team; and

WHEREAS, the public purpose of this contribution will be used to pay for training and equipment for the hazardous materials team; and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the contribution received;

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are appropriations funds of \$260,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2022 budget; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Saint Paul, that the \$260,000 is available for appropriation in the 2022 budget, and said budget, as heretofore adopted by Council, is hereby amended as outlined in the attached financial analysis.
