Approving the temporary installation of artwork in the public right of way on the City's signal cabinets on the northeast corner of University Avenue and Marion Street.

WHEREAS, the St. Paul City School wishes to wrap the City's signal cabinets and install artwork designed by an artist; and

WHEREAS, RES 19-1622 adopted by City Council on September 18, 2019, provides the permitting policy and process for the review and approval of public art proposed in the right of way, and sets forth general conditions for artwork installation; and

WHEREAS, applicant has submitted complete and proper applications for the project which meet all conditions laid out in RES 19-1622; and

WHEREAS, as outlined in the approval process of RES 19-1622, Public Works has reviewed the St. Paul City Schools' application; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works is recommending approval of the application; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Saint Paul grants approval to Public Works to authorize the installation of the public art project in the right of way.
