Ratifying the assessments for Securing and/or Emergency Boarding services during August 2022. (File No. J2303B, Assessment No. 238102)

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 22-1588 accepted the Report of Completion for Securing and/or Emergency Boarding of a Structure on Private Properties during the month of August 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on February 8, 2023 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered and found satisfactory the assessment of benefits, costs and expenses for the services provided; now, therefore be it
