Amending the financing and spending plans in the Fire Department in the amount of \$31,500 for the 2022 Hazardous Material Emergency Preparedness Grant.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department applied for and received a grant of \$31,500 from the State of Minnesota for the 2022 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant to provide hazardous materials training for firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the grant includes an in-kind match of \$7,875 which will be met with firefighters salaries that are attending the training; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department received approval to apply for this grant on RES 23-169; and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not bee established for the grant received; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation of funds of \$31,500 in excess of those estimated in the 2023 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the following additional changes be made to the 2023 budget:
