WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul, Police Department (SPPD) wishes to enter into a Joint Powers Agreement with the State of Minnesota, acting through its Commissioner of Public Safety on behalf of the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA); and

WHEREAS, the SPPD wishes to use the CJDN application access data in support of its official duties, and

WHEREAS, upon execution, this agreement will become effective and expire five (5) years from its effective date, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that council authorizes the City of Saint Paul to enter into and Assistant Chief Jack Serier to implement the Joint Powers Agreement with the State of Minnesota, on behalf of the BCA.
