Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): PO states that they paid their garbage bill in October 2023. They paid \$73.00, which they state is even more than what they owed.
Staff Comments: Property owner provided proof of payment to WM of \$73.00 on 10-2-2023. WM has confirmed that they received this payment. The invoice for Q4 - 2023 was only \$62.48, so WM also owes property owner a credit of \$10.52.
