Ratifying the assessment for the City's cost of providing Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during April to June 2024. (File No. CG2403A2, Assessment No. 240116)

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 24-1308 accepted the Report of Completion for Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during April to June 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on November 6, 2024 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered and found satisfactory the assessment of benefits, costs and expenses for the services provided; and

WHEREAS, the assessment amount for each property will be payable in a term of 1 year, with the property taxes in 2025; unless specified by the Legislative Hearing Officer's recommended amendments:

- RLH TA 24-419: 1209 Dayton Avenue;
- RLH TA 24-418: 836 Rose Avenue East;
- RLH TA 24-427: 674 Virginia Street;
- RLH TA XX-XX: 1641 Ross Avenue - to delete for separate consideration; to refer to January 2, 2205 Legislative Hearing and continued public hearing to January 22, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the assessment will include an administrative fee of \$2.50 per parcel when collected through property taxes; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 443.29 and Admin. Code § 60.03, the assessment is hereby in all

respects ratified.
