Staff Comments: Legal duplex that was recently split into three condos. The condo conversion never happened and the GC/prop manager passed away. Owner is remodeling so he can sell as legal duplex. The third floor has always been uninhabitable and needs a staircase, but it was billed for one 96. Staff recommends removing assessment.
