Grant a 1-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the lower unit north bedroom; grant a .5-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window in the lower unit south bedroom; grant the appeal for the upper unit third floor bedroom on the condition that property owner disclosed on the lease agreement that the room is not to be used as a bedroom.
