Appeal of Renewal by Andersen, on behalf of Dan Baggenstoss, to an Egress Window Non-Compliance Determination at 1635 HARTFORD AVENUE.

We are appealing 1 replacement double hung that is located in an upper level attic. The room is being converted to be used for sleeping purposes. Changing the operation of the current window will decrease the openable width substantially. Double hung is the best option for the largest egress opening. Please approve.
