Approving adverse action against all licenses held by Shamrock Market, LLC, d/b/a Shamrock Market, 279 McKnight Road South.

WHEREAS, adverse action was taken against all licenses held by Shamrock Market, LLC d/b/a Shamrock Market (License ID #20090002089) for the premises located at 279 McKnight Road South in Saint Paul by Notice of Intent to Suspend Licenses dated October 5, 2011, alleging licensee failed to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$847.00, complete and return the questionnaire at the bottom of the Renewal Invoice and submit and a completed Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law form; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office also recommended a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Suspend Licenses to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the required information or request a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Suspend Licenses stated that if the licensee failed to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the required information or request a hearing by October 17, 2011, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that all licenses held by Shamrock Market, LLC d/b/a Shamrock Market are hereby suspended for failure to pay delinquent license and late fees.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the licensee is ordered to pay a matrix penalty of \$500.00 for failure to submit required information. Payment of such penalty shall be made within thirty (30) days of the date of the adoption of this resolution.
