Setting the date of Public Hearing for October 5, 2011 for ratification of 2011 Right-of-Way Maintenance Assessment Program charges to be assessed against benefitted properties.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Saint Paul, pursuant to Chapter 62 of the Administrative Code did hold a public hearing on November 3, 2010, in the City Council Chambers for the purpose of establishing the level of Right-of-Way maintenance to be performed in the City of Saint Paul and the amount of service charges to be levied against benefitted properties; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works did perform the 2011 Right-of-Way maintenance services in a manner as set forth and approved by the City Council and described in the report of the Department of Public Works; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the benefitted properties shall be assessed according to the following rates:
