Appeal of Robert J. Polski, Jr. to a Fire Certificate of Occupancy Correction Notice at 1068 SUMMIT AVENUE.

#2 of deficiency list is appealed because windows are large enough to provide egress and ingress for occupants or emergency personnel. #4 is appealed because dishwasher is not a required or supplied piece of equipment. #6 is vague and does not provide enough information to address.

Yes, lower north - 6 inches in egress opening height, upper north - 5 inches in egress opening height, upper south - 5 inches egress opening height.

Hearing required on lower south. However, it looks like this window has the correct overall dimensions, but that it isn't opening all the way. Can this be checked. Hearing on rest of balance.
