Approving adverse action against the Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer - Each Add'l Vehicle licenses held by CB Industries, Inc., d/b/a Arbortech Stump & Tree Removal.

WHEREAS, adverse action was taken against the Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer - Each Add'l Vehicle licenses held by CB Industries, Inc. d/b/a Arbortech Stump & Tree Removal (License ID #20110004042) for the City of Saint Paul, by Notice of Intent to Suspend Licenses dated February 20, 2013, alleging licensee failed to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$467.00, and submit the following information: 1) current vehicle information; 2) current certificate of General Liability insurance; 3) proof of registration with the Commissioner of Agriculture; 4) proof that one of their employees possesses certification as an arborist from the ISA and 5) a completed Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law form; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office also recommended a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Suspend Licenses to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit required information or request a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Suspend Licenses stated that if the licensee failed to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit required information or request a hearing by March 1, 2013, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Tree Trimmer & 1 Vehicle and Tree Trimmer - Each Add'l Vehicle licenses held by CB Industries, Inc. d/b/a Arbortech Stump & Tree Removal are hereby suspended for failure to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$467.00.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the licensee is ordered to pay a matrix penalty of \$500.00 for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license.

The license will remain suspended until all license fees and penalties are paid in full and all required information is submitted to the Department of Safety and Inspections.
