Appeal of Richard G. Wolfgramm to a Vacant Building Registration Notice at 46 DELOS STREET WEST.

WHEREAS, in the matter of the Appeal of Richard G. Wolfgramm to a Vacant Building Registration Notice at 46 DELOS STREET WEST, the Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed the appeal and considered the testimony of City staff and the appellant; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Hearing Officer recommends that the City Council 1) waive the Vacant Building fee for 90 days and allow; 2) allow the owner to pull permits to make repairs in this 90-day time period, without first paying the vacant building fee or getting a code compliance inspection; and 3) allow the owner 90 days to get his Fire Certificate of Occupancy reinstated before requiring a code compliance certificate before reoccupation; Now, Therefore, Be It

RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council hereby accepts and adopts the Legislative Hearing Officer's recommendation in this matter.
