Establishing a policy for the placement and maintenance of roll-off dumpsters in the right-of-way.

AMENDED 8/20/14

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul finds that the use of roll-off dumpsters, also known as hook-lift containers, present potential health and safety concerns to the community; and

WHEREAS, these health and safety concerns relate to location of the roll-off dumpster with the City's right of way, dumpster maintenance and dumpster movement in accordance with the City's parking regulations; and

WHEREAS, health and safety concerns also arise from the misuse of roll-off dumpsters with regard to placement of hazardous materials into a dumpster - whether its use for construction or non-construction materials and debris; and

WHEREAS, effective signage on dumpsters will alert the community at large, roll-off dumpster companies and the users of roll-off dumpsters of safety and health requirements; and

WHEREAS, placement of dumpsters in the City's right of way can cause dangerous conditions for motorists and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, a revised fee structure for the use of roll-off dumpsters will encourage efficient use of the City's rights of way; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council adopts the policies and practices described in the attachment to this resolution; and

RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council adopts the following fee structure, effective January 15~~1~~, 2015 for placement of dumpsters, container and storage units in the City's right of way:

\$7 per day for non-downtown place for ~~January 2015~~ first 30 days in the right-of-way;

\$10 per day for non-downtown place for ~~February through May 2015~~ next 90 days in the right-of-way (days 31-120);

\$15 per day for non-downtown place for ~~June 2015 moving forward~~ 121 days or longer;

\$14 per day for non-metered downtown streets; and

RESOLVED, that these policies shall be updated from time to time ~~provided notice is given to the City Council at least 60 days in advance of the proposed changes~~ within the Adopted City Budget.
