Authorizing the Department of Parks and Recreation to partner with Neighborhood House to submit a Ramsey County Soccer Partners grant application for \$50,000 to help fund field improvements at the Paul and Sheila Wellstone Center/El Rio Vista Recreation Center.

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul and Neighborhood House jointly occupy and operate the facility known as the Paul and Sheila Wellstone Center/El Rio Vista Recreation Center located at 179 Robie Street, St. Paul, Minnesota, 55107; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul is the owner of the recreational fields located at the facility and Neighborhood House uses them as part of their programming; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul currently has Capital Improvement Budget funding for field improvements at El Rio Vista in the amount of \$1,510,000; and
