Comments: Initial inspection took place on 4/29/2014; a CN was not sent to owner until 6/20/14. Property was re-inspected on 11/26/14 and an extension was granted to 5/1/15. Property was re-inspected on 10/26/15 and EC was issued for non-compliance. Property was re-inspected on 12/9/15 and another EC was issued for non-compliance. Owner contacted the inspector and was granted an extension to 5/1/16 to repair the retaining wall.

History of Orders on Property:

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Excessive Inspection/Abatement services billed during October 22 to November 20, 2015. (File No. J1607E, Assessment No. 168308) and the assessment roll including all properties for which these assessments are proposed for Council ratification; and
