



## Legislation Text

Approving the application of Visit Saint Paul for a sound level variance to use live music and DJs on the street and in fully enclosed tents in an area on Seventh Street West between 174 Seventh Street West and 258 Seventh Street West during the Visit Saint Paul Crashed Ice Village Event on February 4, 2017.

WHEREAS, Chapter 293 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code was enacted to regulate the subject of noise in the City of Saint Paul; and

WHEREAS, §293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in §293.07, upon a finding by the City Council that full compliance with Chapter 293 would constitute an unreasonable hardship on the applicant, other persons or on the community; and

WHEREAS, Visit Saint Paul, represented by Adam Johnson, Vice President of Marketing, who has been designated as the responsible person on the application, has applied for a variance to provide use of a DJ with speakers on 7<sup>th</sup> Street West outside Tom Reid's, 258 7<sup>th</sup> Street West and at Eagle Street/The Liffey, 174 7<sup>th</sup> Street West; for a DJ/Live Music from fully enclosed tents at Burger Moe's Parking Lot, 242 7<sup>th</sup> Street West, Cossetta's Parking Lot, 211 7<sup>th</sup> Street West, and for use of a DJ with music on the street under an overhang in front of Cossetta's, 211 7<sup>th</sup> Street West; and

WHEREAS, applicant is seeking a variance, with a sound level request of 100 decibels at 50 feet from the source of all locations from 2:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m., and a level of 95 decibels 50 feet from the source from 11:00 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. within the tent contained locations, with outside music from DJ's to cease at 11:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, if applicant is not granted a variance applicant will not be able to provide the use of live music, DJs on 7<sup>th</sup> Street West: Tom Reid's, 258 7<sup>th</sup> Street West and at Eagle Street/The Liffey, 174 7<sup>th</sup> Street West; for a DJ/Live Music from fully enclosed tents at Burger Moe's Parking Lot, 242 7<sup>th</sup> Street West, Cossetta's Parking Lot, 211 7<sup>th</sup> Street West, with use of a DJ with music under an overhang in front of Cossetta's, 211 7<sup>th</sup> Street West; during the Crashed Ice Village Visit Saint Paul Event; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Safety and Inspections has reviewed the application and has made recommendations regarding conditions for the variance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Saint Paul hereby grants a variance to Adam Johnson, subject to the following conditions:

1) The variance shall be for the hours of 2:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. in the street on West 7<sup>th</sup> Street on February 4, 2017 outside Tom Reid's, 258 7<sup>th</sup> Street West and at Eagle Street/The Liffey, 174 7<sup>th</sup> Street West, and under the overhang in front of Cossetta's, 211 7<sup>th</sup> Street West and in fully enclosed tents from 2:00 p.m. on February 4, 2017 until 1:00 a.m. on February 5, 2017 for a DJ/Live Music from tents at Burger Moe's Parking Lot, 242 7<sup>th</sup> Street West, Cossetta's Parking Lot, 211 7<sup>th</sup> Street West, during the Crashed Ice Village Visit Saint Paul Event.

2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 95 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources outside on the street from 2:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. on February 4, 2017, and not exceed 80 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source outside of the fully enclosed

tents from 11:00 p.m. on February 4, 2017 until 1:00 a.m. on February 5, 2017.

3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound mix during the hours of the variance.

4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 11:00 p.m. on February 4, 2017 in the street and no later than 1:00 a.m. on February 5, 2017 in the tents.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on any of the dates may result in revocation of the grant of a noise variance for the subsequent date(s), in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Visit Saint Paul, represented by Adam Johnson, Vice President of Marketing, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to provide live music and DJs, on the street in an area between 174 7<sup>th</sup> Street West and 258 7<sup>th</sup> Street West and in fully enclosed tents at 242 7<sup>th</sup> Street West and at 211 7<sup>th</sup> Street West during the Visit Saint Paul Crashed Ice Village Event on February 4, 2017, with limitations. The Variance is requested from 2:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. in the street and from fully enclosed tents on West 7<sup>th</sup> Street from 2:00 p.m. on February 4, 2017 until 1:00 a.m. on February 5, 2017. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
