Approving the application with conditions, per the Deputy Legislative Hearing Officer, for Auto Body Repair and Auto Repair licenses (change of ownership) for Ivy Auto and Repair LLC (License # 20170004654), d/b/a Ivy Auto Body and Repair, 45 Ivy Avenue West.

WHEREAS, the Deputy Legislative Hearing Officer recommends that the application for Auto Body Repair and Auto Repair licenses (change of ownership) for Ivy Auto and Repair LLC (License # 20170004654), d/b/a Ivy Auto Body and Repair be approved with the following conditions:

1. All auto repair and/or auto body repair work shall be done within an enclosed building. No repair of vehicles may occur on the exterior of the lot or in the public right-of-way. Auto body spray painting is not permitted (there is no approved paint booth).

2. Customer and employee vehicles shall be parked in accordance with the approved site plan on file with the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) dated, October 18, 2011 (Site Plan File #08-110651). A maximum of eleven (11) vehicles associated with the business may be parked on the premises at any time, with the site plan showing these spaces located in the northeast corner of the property.

3. Space on the lot shall be maintained at all times to provide maneuvering space to allow vehicles to proceed forward, when entering and exiting the site. Backing from the street or on to the street is prohibited.

4. Employee and customer vehicles may not be parked or stored in the public right-of-way (e.g., alley, sidewalk, boulevard, street, etc.).

Customer vehicles may not be parked longer than ten (10) days on the premises. It shall be the responsibility of the licensee to ensure that any vehicle not claimed by its owner is removed from the lot as permitted by law. At no time shall vehicles be parked in the driveway or in the public Right-of-Way.
There shall be no exterior storage of vehicle parts, tires, oil or any other similar materials associated with

the business, unless placed in a covered dumpster. Storage and disposal of vehicle fluids, batteries, tires, etc. shall be in accordance with the Ramsey County Hazardous Waste regulations.

7. Vehicle salvage, the collection or acceptance of vehicles for the purpose of salvaging parts for re-sale and/or re-use is expressly forbidden.

8. Auto sales are not permitted.

9. Licensee must comply with all federal, state and local laws.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Saint Paul hereby approves this license application the aforementioned mutually agreed-upon conditions.
