Authorizing the Department of Parks and Recreation to apply for and accept \$8,500 in cost-share funding from the Ramsey-Washington Metro Watershed District for mechanical harvesting of aquatic vegetation on Lake Phalen in 2018.

WHEREAS, the Ramsey-Washington Metro Watershed District (RWMWD) Stewardship Program offers financial assistance for aquatic vegetation harvesting to protect and improve water resources; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul has mechanically harvested aquatic vegetation on Lake Phalen since 2002 and is eligible to receive up to 50% cost-share funding through RWMWD for a 2018 harvest; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation requests permission to apply for and accept up to \$8,500 in cost-share funding from RWMWD to cover contractor costs associated with the 2018 harvest on Lake Phalen; and

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council finds that accepting these grant funds will allow Parks and Recreation to fulfill ecological principles of water resources protection; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Department of Parks and Recreation staff are hereby authorized to seek RWMWD costshare funds on behalf of the City and, if successful, enter into an agreement with the District to accept the funds.
