Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): This was already paid as a credit is being held by the hauler. **Staff Comments**: According to information provided by Republic Services, the property owner had a payment transferred from a previous account to his current acount on 1/24/19. This credit was applied to the Quarter 1 2019 bill because it was transferred after Republic Services already turned over the delinquent amount to the City on 1/5/19. The credit was not applied to the Quarter 4 2018 bill. Because Republic Services has not received payment for Quarter 4 2018, the property owner is responsible for paying the delinquent charge to the City.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Trash Hauling during Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during October to December 2018.
