Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): At the point of getting the invoice from the City of St. Paul I did not realize I had to then pay to St. Paul (did not really read it, just recognized it was for late garbage payment), I made an account with Republic Services and paid off the amount with them on 2/16/19, before the due date on the final notice.

Staff Comments: If the property owner made a payment to the garbage hauler after January 5th, 2019, that payment was applied as a credit on their account. The property owner is still responsible for paying the City any outstanding delinquent balance from Quarter 4 2018.
