**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** We never received a bill for this address. The company was sending the bills to an address in Dallas, Texas which they say you provided them. That is not and never has been our address.

**Staff Comments:** The garbage bill and notices of non-payment were sent to the property owner as listed in Ramsey County property tax records: Federal National Mtg Assoc 14221 Dallas Pkwy Flr 10 Dallas TX 75254-2916. It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure that the garbage bills are being sent to the correct address. The property owner is still responsible to pay the delinquent charge, as garbage service was provided from October through December 2018.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Trash Hauling during Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during October to December 2018 (File No. CG1901D1, Assessment No. 190054) and the assessment roll including all properties for which these assessments are proposed for Council ratification; and
