**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** we bought these properties as vacant properties and never requested garbage services for them.

**Staff Comments**: This property became registered vacant on 3/19/19. Hauler was notified of this. Previous property owner did not pay the bill. Staff recommends reducing assessment by length VB status during Quarter 1, which is \$17.07, and removing late fees. Staff recommends reducing to \$85.37.
