**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** Property owner stated that they made a payment of \$150 to the hauler on 11/26/2019. Therefore they feel that they should not have to pay the assessment.

**Staff Comments:** Hauler confirmed that property owner made the payment of \$150 to their open market account and not to their coordinated collection account. They stated that they have moved the payment of \$150 to the coordinated collection account. Therefore staff recommends removing the assessment.
