Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): Property owner stated that they already paid the assessment of \$4.65 to the hauler as part of their Quarter 2 2020 bill.

Staff Comments: Hauler confirmed that late fee of \$4.65 was paid on April 18 2020. Since the Quarter 1 2020 delinquent bill was sent to the City of Saint Paul on April 5, 2020 as an assessment, the payment would not have been applied to the Quarter 1 2020 bill. Therefore staff recommends approving the assessment.
