**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** Improper billing notice. Ridiculous process. We have not been consistently receiving invoices for garbage from the hauler.

**Staff Comments:** Staff confirmed that the Quarter 3 2020 invoice and Notices of Nonpayment were sent to the correct property owner and mailing address. The payment for the Quarter 3 2020 invoice was not made until 09/04/2020. Therefore, the hauler was justified in adding two late fees of \$4.65 for a total of \$9.30. Staff recommends approving the assessment.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during July to September 2020.
