Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): Property owner stated that the upstairs unit of the property has been vacant since December 2021.

Staff Comments: Hauler records show that the property owner submitted a temporary service hold with Waste Management from 2/19/2022 - 8/14/2022. When the property owner called again on 10/19/2022 about the Quarter 4 2022 invoice, they were told by the Waste Management customer service representative that they were unable to do another temporary service hold and then directed to call the City for assistance. Since the City has no records of the property owner calling for assistance following their conversation with Waste Management, staff recommends approving the assessment since there was no temporary service hold or vacancy applied to the account during that time.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during October to December 2022. (File No. CG2301A2, Assessment No. 230106) and the assessment roll including all properties for which these assessments are proposed for Council ratification; and
