Approving the Mayor's appointment of Mysee Chang and reappointment of Chang Vang to the Public Housing Agency (PHA). (To be withdrawn)

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Public Housing Agency (PHA) is formed to help families and individuals with low incomes achieve greater stability and self-reliance by providing safe, affordable, quality housing, and links to community services; and

WHEREAS, the Public Housing Agency is funded through a combination of tenant fees, federal funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and several State and Local programs; and

WHEREAS, the Public Housing Agency of the City of Saint Paul is a public body corporate and politic organized under Code of Federal Regulations, Title 24, Part 964, Minnesota Statutes, Section 469.003 and Minnesota Session Laws, Chapter 228 (1977) with terms of PHA appointments governed by that enabling legislation requiring that the commissioners be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Public Housing Agency of the City of St. Paul is comprised of a seven-member Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Mysee Chang has applied for an appointment on the Public Housing Agency Board and has been recommended by PHA staff to serve in a seat being vacated by Yer Chang; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Carter wishes to appoint Mysee Chang to the Public Housing Agency to fill the remainder of Yer Chang's term ending September 1, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Chang Vang currently serves as an at-large member of the Public Housing Agency Board and is recommended for reappointment by PHA staff; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Carter wishes to appoint Mysee Chang and reappoint Chang Vang to the Public Housing Agency Board; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council approves the appointment of Mysee Chang to a term on the Public Housing Agency ending September 1, 2027; and be it

FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council approves the reappointment of Chang Vang to a five-year term on the Public Housing Agency ending December 31, 2027.
