## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE - CITY COUNCIL APPEAL**

**Purpose:** An appeal of a decision by the Board of Zoning Appeals denying a variance request to

establish a 12-resident supportive housing facility. The zoning code states that supportive housing facilities shall be a minimum distance of 1,320 feet from specified congregate living facilities with more than six (6) adult residents; this facility is 804 feet from a specified congregate living facility with more than six (6) adult residents, for a variance of 516 feet.
