WHEREAS, The State of Minnesota Department of Public Safety has created and provided grant funding for two new multi-agency Violent Crime Enforcement Teams (VCETs), one in Hennepin County and one in Ramsey County which will be a modification to the previously funded East Metro Narcotics Task Force; and

WHEREAS, The VCET must be established by a Joint Powers Agreement and governed by an advisory board with representatives from each participating law enforcement agency and a representative of the County Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, The previous Joint Powers Agreement creating the East Metro Task Narcotics Task Force will be amended to reflect the change to a Violent Crime Enforcement Team and will operate in accordance with requirements established by the State; and

WHEREAS, Ramsey County has been awarded a VCET grant in the amount of \$530,000 which will be shared among the members of the VCET: Ramsey County Sheriff's Office, the Ramsey County Attorney's Office, the St. Paul Police Department, and the Lino Lakes, Maplewood, North St. Paul, Roseville and White Bear Lake Police Departments; and

WHEREAS, \$65,000 of the grant funds will be earmarked to sub-contract with community agencies to provide crime prevention services; and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Office requests approval of an increase in the personnel complement by one Community Service Officer FTE to be used as an Analyst within the Sheriff's Office and starred in the personnel complement; and





Perform and accomplish such purposes and activities as specified herein and in the Grantee’s approved Violent Crime Enforcement Teams 2022 Application (“Application”) which is incorporated by reference into this grant contract agreement and on file with the State at 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 2300, St. Paul, Minnesota, 55101-2139. The Grantee shall also comply with all requirements referenced in the Violent Crime Enforcement Teams 2022 Guidelines and Application which includes the Terms and Conditions and Grant Program Guidelines (<https://app.dps.mn.gov/EGrants>), which are incorporated by reference into this grant contract agreement.

Budget Revisions: The breakdown of costs of the Grantee’s Budget is contained in Exhibit A, which is attached and incorporated into this grant contract agreement. As stated in the Grantee’s Application and Grant Program Guidelines, the Grantee will submit a written change request for any substitution of budget items or any deviation and in accordance with the Grant Program Guidelines. Requests must be approved prior to any expenditure by the Grantee.

Matching Requirements: (If applicable.) As stated in the Grantee’s Application, the Grantee certifies that the matching requirement will be met by the Grantee.



Payment: As stated in the Grantee's Application and Grant Program Guidance, the State will promptly pay the Grantee after the Grantee presents an invoice for the services actually performed and the State's Authorized Representative accepts the invoiced services and in accordance with the Grant Program Guidelines. Payment will not be made if the Grantee has not satisfied reporting requirements.
