Ana Silva:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on Tuesday, April 8, 2025 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond recommended that the City Council grant to May 2, 2025 for compliance with the March 26 Summary Abatement Order (including removal of minifridge).

As discussed in the hearing, the City does provide households with one bulky item pick-up per calendar month with regular garbage service. These pickups are included in the cost of your regular collection. **Contact the City at least two business days in advance of your garbage collection day** to request a pickup. Fill out the <u>online request form</u> or call 651-266-6101. If you wish to move forward with installation of a fence, you do need to submit a site plan to the Department of Safety & Inspections Plan review. This matter will go before the City Council at Public Hearing on **Wednesday, April 23, 2025 at 3:30 pm. in room 300 City Hall.** If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation you may:

1. appear in person (*please arrive before 3:30 p.m. and check in with staff outside Council chambers when you arrive*); or

2. Should you wish testify to Council directly by phone, you must register to do so online by no later than noon on Tuesday, April 22, 2025 here:

If you don't wish to contest then <u>no further action is needed</u> and the Council will proceed with Ms. Moermond's recommendation above without discussion. <u>If you will be contesting please</u> <u>call our office no later than close of business Monday April 21 so we may provide an</u> <u>interpreter for you.</u>

After the April 23 Public Hearing, Ms. Moermond will review this case under a new resolution at an May 6 Legislative Hearings at 11:00 a.m. to determine if you have abated the nuisance(s) listed above on deadline. The City Council Public Hearing will be scheduled for Wednesday, May 7, 2025 at 3:30 pm. in room 300 City Hall. You are welcome to attend any of these hearings. If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation from the May 6 Legislative Hearing, you may appear in person or, **should you wish to address testify by phone you must register by noon on the Tuesday May 6 via the link above.**
