RE: The summary abatement order for 1552 Canfield Avenue, St. Paul, MN 55108

This summary abatement order is greatly over exaggerated and misleading at best. It appears that I am being targeted by a disgruntled neighbor, and the issuer, Allan Vang, did not clearly identify items.

The order list vs. the actual item and status:

- Cardboards (sic) – one cardboard box in back of garage that did not fit in the recycling can – recycled at Environmental Center.
- Furnitures (sic) – one side table in back of garage previously used for my table saw – disposed of before I received the notice. Possibly the cat catio (wooden structure in the side yard standing upright) - not illegal.
- Rubber Matts (sic) – two rubber auto mats and one fabric auto mat left for failed Buy Nothing pickup – disposed of.
- Scrap Plastic Crates and Contents – seven empty milk crates and plastic basket for harvesting and storing produce – back in garage.
- Scrap Woods (sic) – three pieces 1/4x2x3 and 12 1x3s (old rabbit hutch) - disposed of. Tomato supports and trellis' – not illegal.
- Tables – patio furniture – one round and 3 small square – chairs, bench - not illegal.
- Scrap Woodboards (sic)– brand new lumber (2x4s, 2x2s, and 1x3s) leaning on the garage – now a storage rack.
- Scrap Metals and Poles – Possibly removeable fence posts taken out during the neighbor's fence installation – fence to be reinstalled.
- Scrap Plastics and Contents – Empty plastic storage bins – back in garage - recycling bins and outdoor cat shelter – not illegal.
- Scrap Plastic Buckets and Contents – eight empty food grade buckets for produce storage – back in garage.
- Automotive Parts/Batteries – one battery in back yard – back in garage.
- Straw Bales – one partial straw bale for weed suppression – not illegal.
- Scrap Plastic Poles – PVC pipe drip irrigation system. See storage rack.
- Tarps and Contents – one air conditioner cover – back in garage.
- Water in Kiddie Pool – emptied.
- Scrap Plastic Barrells – 4 rain barrels - not illegal.
- Miscellaneous Debris – tonka trucks, wheel barrel, lawn chairs, fire pit, patio umbrellas, outdoor plant racks, screen, playground ladder, etc. - not illegal.

Summary:

- Scrap and Furnitures (sic) Disposal - 1 cardboard box, 1 side table, 3 auto mats, 15 small pieces of scrap wood
- Back in garage- 7 empty milk crates, 8 empty buckets, 1 battery, 1 AC cover, and plastic storage bins
- Emptied – kiddie pool

Outstanding: Side of the garage/yard - the drip irrigation system (PVC pipes and connectors) to be sorted and stored in the new storage rack – additional time is needed and requested. FYI – The garage cleanout is scheduled for the next two weeks, so items may be temporarily left outside again while doing that. Thanks.

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal before **8/10/2026**, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

Charges: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipment, etc. The rate will be approximately \$450 per hour plus expenses for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times. Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation
