Hi, Here are a few responses:

- What would make this grant more workable for your organization? There's potential for most of the funds to be pass through so the grant should have a 15 percent admin fee to make sure nonprofits are compensated for their time.
- What should be the maximum grant amount? This depends on the total budget but I think \$75k per corridor would be meaningful and could make an impact.
- What activities should be eligible for funding, in addition to (or instead of) what's proposed?
