We're delighted that you represent us on the city council, and we are writing to express our concern about the increase in our property tax along with an increase in our home value. Our assessed value increased by @4% but our property taxes increased by 13%—significantly higher than the reported average increases from St.Paul, Ramsey County and IDS 625. While the property assessment may be correct, we object to paying property tax increases at a disproportionately higher rate than other residents and businesses. An increase in property value along with a higher than average increase in tax rate seems excessive and likely not sustainable for current residents or attractive to those considering a move to St. Paul.
