# HRA Real Estate Update




#### Phase I

• Identify, research, and itemize HRA owned parcels.

#### Phase II

- Establish cross division work group.
- Develop strategy for disposition of properties.





#### Methods of disposition:

- Proposals the HRA receives via third parties.
- Requests for proposals.



Request for Proposals	Competitive process with specific goals, criteria, and timeline
Unsolicited Proposals	Can be submitted at any time, subject to criteria in disposition policy, requires 45-day ENS notice to inform public/allow for competing proposals
Garden sites	Sites used for gardens enter into a one-year license agreement to allow the use
Side lot sales	Sales to adjacent properties for parcels that meeting HRA's definition of a splinter parcel or side lot
Transfer to City	Transfer to City ownership to be operated as part of a park, use for City ROW, or has another longer-term public purpose
Parking ramps	Long term holds by the HRA to be used as parking facilities



# Location of HRA Properties in Ward 2 Thursday, August 21, 2025





# Location of HRA Properties in Ward 4 Wednesday, August 6, 2025




