Dear Saint Paul Water Commissioners,

Please consider this correspondence to be an on-the-record comment for next Tuesday's public hearing.

At a meeting this past Tuesday, City Councilmember Molly Coleman cited unspecified "legal obligations" that would prevent her from voting against the Waterfall contract if it receives a "strong recommendation" from the evaluation committee. She also cited the Constitution and our system of federalism as barriers.

Anticipating that other Commissioners might have similar reservations about voting 'no' to the evaluation committee's recommendation, I would like to share with you all a Department of Justice opinion from 1986 titled *Constitutionality of South African Divestment Statutes Enacted by State and Local Governments*.

The opinion clearly states that such laws "survive constitutional scrutiny". It goes on to say:

The divestment laws do not place an impermissible burden on foreign commerce. Under the market participation doctrine, the Supreme Court has held that proprietary, as opposed to governmental, actions of state and local governments may be shielded from the strictures of the Commerce Clause. The divestment laws fall within that doctrine. Nor do such laws represent an unconstitutional interference with the federal government's foreign affairs power.

I welcome your thoughts on any perceived constraints, legal or otherwise, that might prevent you from voting to economically disengage from Israel.

Dear Council Council Member Coleman:

I am writing to register my opposition to continuation of the Water Board's contract with Waterfall. As you know, I am sure, the Israeli government has conducted ethnic cleansing throughout Palestine and implemented a genocide in Gaza. Estimates of the dead range up to 680,000 people. I find it offensive that the Water Board would consider contracting with an Israeli firm that has a relationship with that activity.

There is no credible legal obstacle to canceling the current relationship with Waterfall. Perhaps the closest example of local actions would be the many steps local governments took to isolate South African apartheid. I assume the Water Board would not feel prevented from canceling a relationship with firm in Nazi Germany if the situation was different.

I suspect that some Board members or staff have been told that opposing Israel is anti-semitic, and by extension, opposing genocide is anti-semitic. This is not true. Rather, taking a position of opposition to the brutal behavior of Israel is a highly moral and principled stand. Recent polls indicate that most Americans agree that Israel has become an outlaw state. Even many Jews are ashamed of and embarrassed by Israel's genocide.

I hope you will oppose renewal of the Waterfall contract.

Dear Mayor Carter,

I have followed your response to the shootings of the kids at Annunciation church in Minneapolis. Thank you for speaking out about the violence.

As I have listened to the various comments from many outraged community members, I kept comparing these local killings to those in Palestine. We have properly spoken out about the killings of two children and the wounding of 21 others here at home. But there has been little response to the slaughter in Palestine, particularly in Gaza.

The "official" number of those killed in Gaza is now about 62,000. Maybe half of those killed were children. But that number counts only the bodies identified by the health centers and other emergency services. If we are to include those Palestinians killed and buried under the rubble of the bombed buildings, and those killed by disease, and those dying from no food or water, the actual number killed by the Israelis may be 200,000 to 300,000.

Why hasn't Archbishop Hebda called all Catholics to come to a prayer service at the Cathedral where he would initiate an Archdiocese-wide campaign to stop the genocide? Why haven't the Mayors of Minnesota declared that they will no longer do business with Israeli firms? Why can't Governor Walz do the same for State agencies? Or the University of Minnesota?

I understand that all this is easier said than done. And I understand that there are sinister and powerful forces at work behind the scenes that will oppose taking these steps.

But there is strong and growing support for taking actions like these. Recent polling indicates that a substantial majority of Americans are outraged by the genocide. The percentage of Democrats is even higher. And I suspect that the percentage of people in St. Paul who reject Israel's slaughter in Gaza is higher still. My point is that it would be politically popular, not risky, to oppose the apartheid and ethnic cleansing in concrete ways, and not only by your words.

One step you could take now is to instruct your Water Board to cancel the contract with Waterfall Security Solutions. Yes, it's a small step compared to what needs to be done to bring this horror to an end. But little things add up. That's how we ended apartheid in South Africa.

As I understand it, the Water Board will be considering this issue on September 9. I would be happy to sit down with you, privately, one-on-one, if you think that might be helpful. Or, if you want a taste of what St. Paul thinks, come to a Friday afternoon rally at the corner of Snelling and Summit. I would be happy to act as your host; you can see the overwhelmingly positive reaction from people driving by.

I went to Palestine and Israel a few years ago, before the current assault on Gaza. Even then, it was crystal-clear that there were two separate, unequal societies there: a privileged and affluent Israel and an abused and repressed Palestine.

I hope you will do the right thing.

VFP Chapter 27 Statement on the Contract with Waterfall

July 13, 2026

Israel is an apartheid nation. Its Law of Return, Nation State Law and, most recently, Death Penalty for Terrorists Law are designed to perpetuate Jewish supremacy over the indigenous Palestinian population. In practice, the pillars of apartheid have been present in Israel and the Occupied Palestinian Territories for decades: ethnic/religious classification, geographic separation, segregated infrastructure, discriminatory laws, discriminatory enforcement of the law, separate courts, and separate prisons.

Israel is also credibly accused of genocide. In January of 2024, the International Court of Justice found that Israel was plausibly committing genocide in Gaza. Since that time, several respected human rights organizations including Amnesty International, Human Rights Watch, and the International Association of Genocide Scholars have determined that the threshold for genocide has been met.

The non-violent strategy of economic isolation was successful in forcing South Africa to dismantle its system of apartheid. By the end of 1989, 26 states and over 90 cities had taken some form of binding economic action against South Africa. Many cities used selective purchasing policies, whereby preference in bidding on contracts was given to companies that did not reside in, or do business with, South Africa.

The dire situation in Gaza and the West Bank demands similar action today.

At least one Water Commissioner has expressed concern that a 'no' vote on the recommended contract with Waterfall would constitute discrimination on the basis of national origin, and therefore transgress legal obligations of this Board.

In 1986, the US Department of Justice found that state and local efforts to confront apartheid in South Africa were lawful.

The opinion clearly states that such laws "survive constitutional scrutiny". It goes on to say:

The divestment laws do not place an impermissible burden on foreign commerce. Under the market participation doctrine, the Supreme Court has held that proprietary, as opposed to governmental, actions of state and local governments may be shielded from the strictures of the Commerce Clause. The divestment laws fall within that doctrine. Nor do such laws represent an unconstitutional interference with the federal government's foreign affairs power.

This opinion applies to apartheid Israel today. Punitive measures imposed on a nation that embraces a *de jure* system of apartheid, and is credibly accused of genocide, is not in itself discrimination. It is an attempt to remedy grave injustice.

For those who would forgo the South African model of confronting apartheid, and believe that individual companies should not be sanctioned for merely residing in the apartheid state, you are reminded again of the background and recent statements made by Waterfall's founder and CEO, Lior Frenkel. After a six-year stint in the Israeli Air Force doing "the intelligence part of the

business”, Mr. Frenkel founded a company that conducted “offensive cybersecurity” for the Israeli government. In light of all the nefarious cyber weapons employed by Israel, the Stuxnet virus, Pegasus, Lavender, Where’s Daddy, and exploding pagers, this should be a red flag for all, and ample predicate for an investigation by the Department of Human Rights and Equal Economic Opportunity.

This procurement process has been a sham from the start, and biased in favor of Waterfall Security Solutions. The original 2024 agreement, Contract 4889, was non-competitive and the single source justification faulty. Presented with a critique of the process, the SPRWS Information Services Manager did not proceed with corrective measures, but rather instructed staff that “we need to build our case to continue to support this system”. Recognizing that “it may appear like we presented a weak argument for single source”, she also sought to retrospectively bolster the justification asking the City’s Chief Information Security Officer if there was any precedent for “use[ing] single source for cybersecurity reasons”. Somehow, the Information Services Manager was subsequently appointed to the evaluation committee.

The enabling resolution for the RFI that followed was comically biased. Thanks to the efforts of Commissioner Coleman, some of that biased language was removed, but the true purpose of the RFI can still be found in the BOWC minutes of September 2025: “To affirm the use of Waterfall Security Solutions’ unidirectional gateway technology”.

Suspecting the Waterfall bias at SPRWS to be chronic, a preview of the RFI’s language was requested, but denied. Suspicions were confirmed upon its issuance:

This RFI is for informational purposes only and no contract will be awarded as a result. Participation or lack of participation in this RFI will have no impact on the evaluation of responses to any subsequent RFP or Invitation to Bid (ITB).

SPRWS may request vendor demonstrations based on the responses received.

Participation in demonstrations will not obligate SPRWS to issue a further solicitation or award a contract.

Respondents are responsible for all costs incurred in preparing responses or participating in demonstrations.

It is not surprising that the RFI garnered only two submissions, one of them from Waterfall. Its language made clear that participation would be a waste of time.

Still, the RFP enabling resolution of January 13, 2026 was encouraging. It called broadly for a “secure OT to IT data transfer solution”, seemingly open to proposals of all available technologies. However, when the RFP was issued, its scope was narrowed to a single technology, the unidirectional data diode, which just so happens to be the existing technology purchased from Waterfall.

As for the amended contract before you, the five-year extension and the elimination of the annual renewal provision are troubling. The current contract with Waterfall is set to auto-renew on August 1st, and the annual renewal provision is an advantageous option for the City. These changes to the terms of the original contract seem designed to shut down anti-apartheid and anti-genocide activists who wish to engage with the City at moments when change is possible. A ‘no’

vote will not leave SPRWS without cyber protection, but it will allow the City annual opportunities to change its mind.

The enabling resolution for the RFP sought a cybersecurity solution that “provides the best overall value for the utility and its ratepayers”. It is unknown how apartheid and genocide factor into the utility’s calculation of value when contracting with a company headquartered in Israel, but ratepayers have been clear; **No Blood in Our Water!**
