## Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm that at the Council Public Hearing on April 17, 2024 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond will ask they refer the matter back to Legislative Hearing on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 9 am in room 330 City Hall/Court House for further discussion after expiration of the redemption period.

## For your reference, the following items would eventually need to be completed before receiving a grant of time from the City Council to rehabilitate the property:

- 1. if you are intending to have a third party rehabilitate the property, pending transfer of title, the contract used for this transaction will need to be approved by the Legislative Hearing Officer. Please note that title cannot transfer until the rehabilitation is complete and nuisance abated;
- 2. outstanding taxes must be brought current;
- **3. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation.** Staff estimates costs to exceed \$100,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis:
- 4. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued;



- **5. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids which address <u>all items in the Code Compliance Inspection Report</u> and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and
- 6. the property must be maintained.

This matter will go before the City Council at Public Hearing on **Wednesday, April 17, 2024 at 3:30 pm. in room 300 City Hall however** no further action is needed and the Council will proceed with Ms. Moermond's recommendation above.
