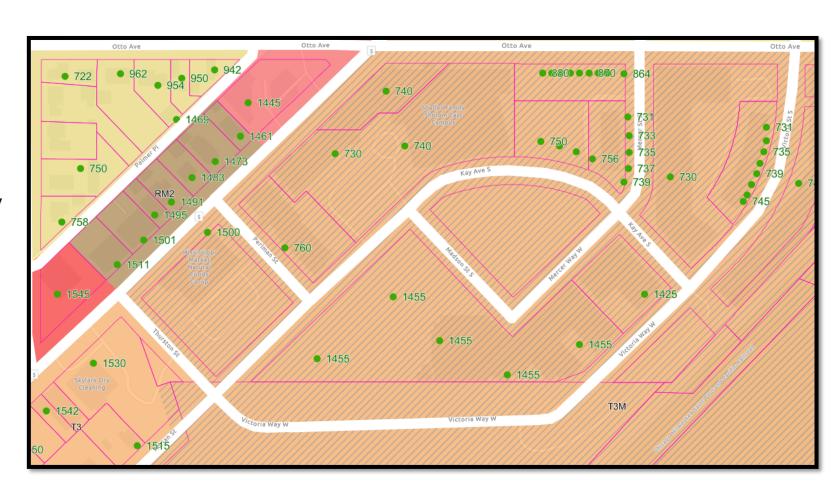

 Application: Amendment to Victoria Park Master Plan to change the parcel designation from mixed-residential to institutional.

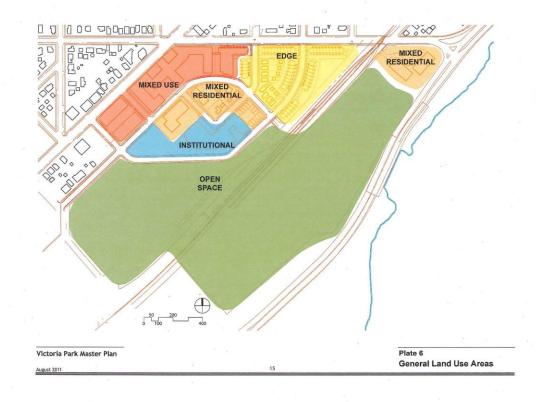




Zoning Committee and Planning Commission

- Zoning Committee: Recommended approval of the Master Plan Amendment and six variances (4-0).
- **Planning Commission:** Recommended approval of the Master Plan Amendment, and approved six variances (passed on a voice vote with two abstentions).

- The Victoria Park Master Plan was first adopted by the Saint Paul City Council in April 2005.
- Also in 2005, approximately half of the Victoria Park Urban Village was rezoned to T3M, while the remaining half's rezoning was delayed due to a lawsuit by Exxon Mobil.



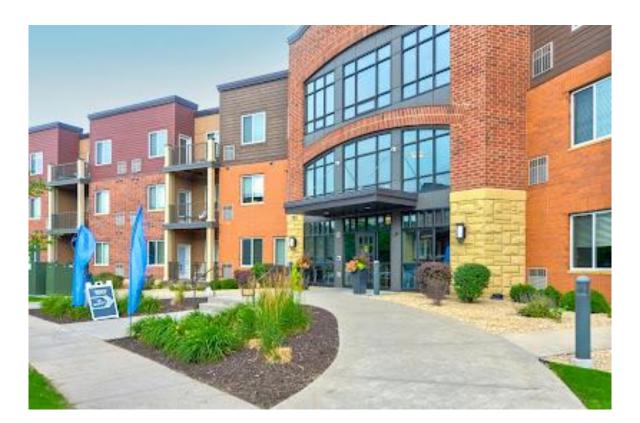
 In 2007, a minor modification of the Victoria Park Master Plan was approved by the Planning Administrator, which added 30 senior units along Otto Ave as part of the Shalom Home campus, subtracted 13 townhomes from the same location, and increased the location's maximum height from 40' to 44'.



- In 2009, the Exxon Mobil lawsuit was settled, and two years later the remainder of the Victoria Park Urban Village was rezoned T3M and I1.
- In 2011, a major modification of the Victoria Park Master Plan was approved by Planning Commission and City Council.



- In 2012, a minor modification of the Victoria Park Master Plan was approved by the Planning Administrator.
- In 2012 two apartment building with approximately 213 units were approved on land identified by the amended Victoria Park Master Plan for townhomes (approximately 48 units).
