Hello Shellie,

Thank you for reaching out to the city of Saint Paul about your garbage bill. Our records indicate you had extra bags out on August 27, which resulted in the charges you see on your invoice. Extra bags are \$4.00 each, plus taxes and fees.

After looking into your concern, the hauler agreed to remove charges for two bags. However, I can no longer adjust the bill without attending a legislative hearing. You do not need to attend, as I have enough information to recommend removal (but I cannot promise or guarantee anything). The hearing is this week, on the morning of March 19. We do the hearing over the phone.

\*\*Please note extra bag fees are applied whenever the lid is open by six inches or more; and large overages or oversized bags will count as more than one bag.
