
9-801 Prohibited Driving Conduct

- (1) No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions. Every driver is responsible for becoming and remaining aware of the actual and potential hazards and must use due care in operating a vehicle.
- (2) No person shall engage in a "reckless driving exhibition". "Reckless driving exhibition" means intentionally:
 - (a) Breaking the traction of the vehicles tires;
 - (b) Unnecessarily spinning the vehicles tires continuously by increasing the engine speed;
 - (c) Steering the vehicle in a manner which is unnecessary to navigate the vehicle; or
 - (d) Stopping a vehicle in an unnecessarily abrupt manner.
- (3) No person shall engage in "street racing". "Street racing" means operation of more than one vehicle in a competitive manner to out-distance each other.
- (4) All vehicles shall have an exhaust system which blends engine noise into overall vehicle noise. No vehicle shall produce a sharp popping or crackling sound. At all times a motor vehicle must comply with the noise rules adopted by the Pollution Control Agency.
- (5) Liability for the crimes of another—The entirety of Minn. Stat. §609.05 are specifically incorporated into this section.
- (6) Penalty. A violation of this Section shall be a misdemeanor.
