Community Outcomes and Expected Impact with Robust Collections Investment

Expected Outcome	Expected Impact
Increase investment in print materials, music and movies for new Bookmobile in 2024.	Increase circulation of library materials on Bookmobile. Increase responsiveness to immediate in-person materials requests from young people.
Increase investment in highest interest print materials, music and movies in three library locations with lower circulation numbers, piloting new community engagement with residents.	Increase visits to library locations. Increase circulation of library materials in key locations. Develop and pilot new community engagement strategy with residents to further align requests with purchases.
Increase availability of high interest materials for elementary and middle school aged youth and teens to capitalize on titles and buckets of interest to young people already using library services.	Capitalize on youth reading interests. Increase responsiveness to immediate in-person materials requests from young people. Increase circulation of library materials.
