What overall feedback do you have on this proposal? I am excited to see that the city is looking to support our business corridors and organizations supporting them.

What would make this grant more workable for your organization? I think this would be very workable but would appreciate more structure and information so applicant know what the timing of the grant is, if this is something a business organization could use a district council as fiscal agent if not established as nonprofit etc.

What should be the maximum grant amount? It is difficult to estimate without knowing what the total pot would be and how many grantees you would hope for each year. I would think \$50,000 would be a good maximum.

What activities should be eligible for funding, in addition to (or instead of) what's proposed? It would be helpful to allow for staff time as well. Since most district councils do not have the capacity to take on more projects due to lack of staffing. It would also be helpful to cover food

and translation costs as well.

How should we ensure that the funds are distributed equitably, while keeping the application process simple? I would like to see a similar process as Cultural STAR where rewardees can not

reapply after receiving funding until the following year.
