What is a Library Program?

- Library programs are events – typically one-time events and activities designed to enrich the library experience.
- They are essential ways libraries add value to the patron experience.
- They align with our Library's mission.

Our Programming Why

- Guided by professional standards that are anchored in intellectual freedom and the rights to read and access information.
- Aligned with the American Library Association's statement on Library-Initiated Programs.
- Designed to enrich services, introduce library resources and further support information access for patrons.

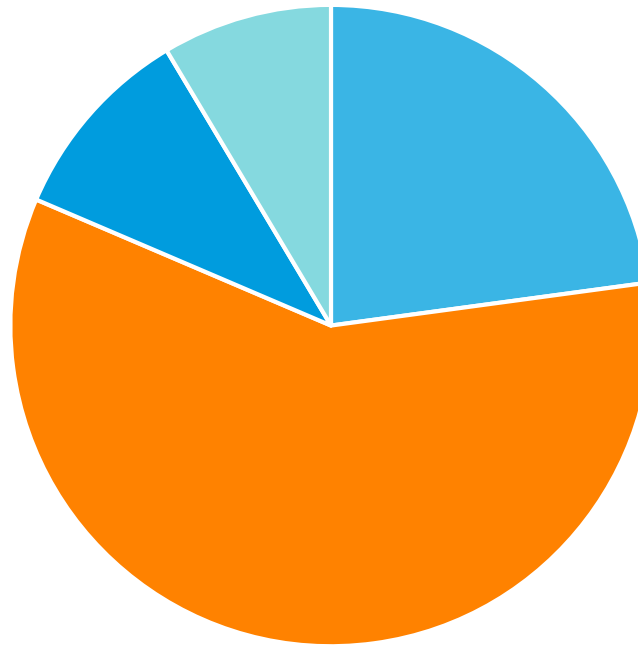
