RE: MINNESOTA REVENUE NOTICE OF LICENSE REVOCATION

Ry Phann:

Enclosed you will find a Notice of License Revocation ("Notice") issued by the Minnesota Department of Revenue ("Department") requiring the City of Saint Paul ("City") to notify you that the City may be required to revoke all licenses issued to Capital Wine and Spirit unless the City receives a clearance certificate from the Department within 30 days. The Notice provides instructions that you must follow for the Department to issue a clearance certificate.

If the City does not receive a clearance certificate within 30 days from the date of this letter, a resolution will be presented to the City Council for revocation of your licenses. The resolution will be heard at the first City Council meeting following the expiration of the 30 days. For this notice, that meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 15, 2026. Once the City Council passes the resolution and it is signed by the Mayor, the City will take action on the revoked licenses.

You may also resolve this matter by cancelling all licenses issued to Capital Wine & Spirit by completing the attached form and submitting it to the Department of Safety and Inspections at 375 Jackson St., Suite 220, St. Paul, MN 55101 within 30 days from the date of this letter.
