- Location: 545 Snelling Avenue N District 11, Ward 4
- Developer: Beacon Interfaith Housing Collaborative
- Four-story building
- Rehab & expansion of existing building
- Total of 98 housing units
- All units are Permanent Supportive Housing and 49 units will serve High Priority Homeless (HPH) individuals

Site History

- Kimball Court was constructed in 1926
- The building was original built as the Hamline Hotel, later renamed the Kimball Hotel
- Civil rights activist, Bayard Rustin, staged an impromptu sit-in at the hotel while visiting the Twin Cities in 1947
- Owned & operated as deeply affordable housing by Amherst H. Wilder Foundation until 2010
- Beacon Interfaith assumed Kimball Court in 2010 and continued its operations as supportive housing



About Beacon

- Affordable housing nonprofit developer for 25 years
- Collaborative of 100 congregations across faith traditions united in a mission to create homes and advance equitable housing so that all people have a home
- Developed, own, and operate 21 properties consisting of 791 multifamily homes
- Recent projects include American House in St. Paul and Vista 44 in Hopkins
